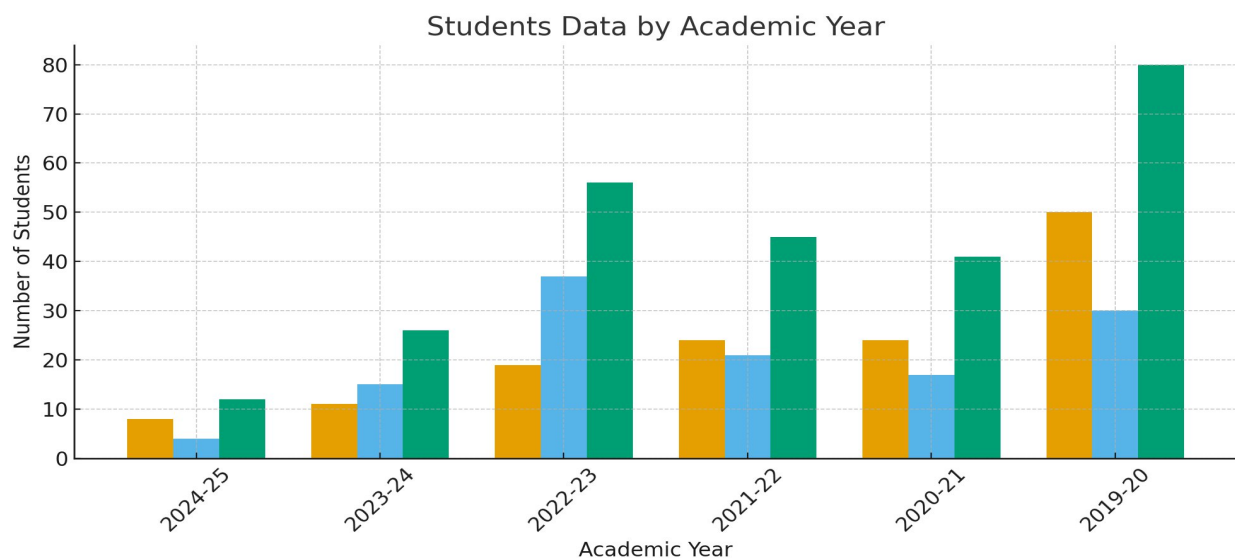

9.LINGUASKILL/ BUSINESS ENGLISH CERTIFICATE (BEC)

The Business English Certificate (BEC) is a skill-based qualification designed to enhance students’ proficiency in practical English communication. It enables learners to develop essential workplace language skills and demonstrate their competence to prospective employers.

Beginning from the academic year 2023–24, Cambridge Linguaskill Certification has been introduced as a replacement for BEC. The St. Joseph’s Group of Institutions is proud to be recognized as a Cambridge Authorized Test Centre for conducting Linguaskill assessments.

Previously, the BEC certification was offered at three levels — *Preliminary*, *Vantage*, and *Higher*. Each year, a diagnostic test was conducted for all students to determine their proficiency level, based on which targeted training sessions were provided.


For the past 12 years, the BEC examinations have been successfully conducted by Cambridge University on our campus. To earn a BEC certificate, students were assessed across four key language skills — *Listening*, *Speaking*, *Reading*, and *Writing*. 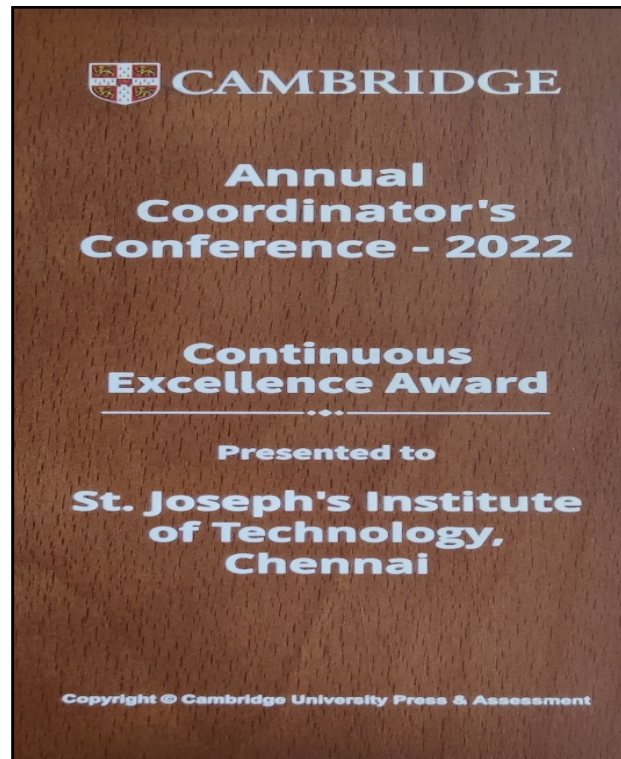
