



#### **OUT COMES**

Businesses rely heavily on analytics to make informed decisions. This FDP began with a comprehensive exploration of existing literature and practices in data analytics, particularly focusing on its application in business decision-making.

The FDP delved into predictive analysis using logistic regression, offering insights into how this model can be used to anticipate outcomes based on historical data. Furthermore, the FDP extended into data analysis using machine learning, exploring its capacity to handle large datasets and uncover hidden patterns that traditional models may miss. A use case application was developed to demonstrate the practical implementation of these methods.
